Nominators must obtain approval from the person being nominated prior to submission and encourage them to be at the banquet.

Nominators may nominate more than one person.

The volunteer service must benefit Marquardt Village residents, clients, patients or anyone served by Marquardt Village staff.

Nominated volunteers must have provided service during the 2017 calendar year, however other years of service will be considered.

The Marquardt Foundation Board of Directors members will be the judges. All decisions are final.

The winner of the award will be announced in the Volunteer Open House invite.

Previous award winners will not be eligible for the award if they have already received the award within the last 5 years.
